AQ Plans Timeline

- Directive 2008/50/EC Supreme Court Order April 2015
- National AQ Plan Published December 2015
 - Mandate for Charging CAZ for 5 authorities
- Plans quashed November 2016
- New National Plan **31st July 2017** (General Election)
 - No longer a mandate for a Charging CAZ
- Public Consultation (3 Options) July 2018
- Second Phase Consultation **November 2018**
- Final Business Case March 2019
- Approval of Derby Scheme by SoS 13th May 2019
